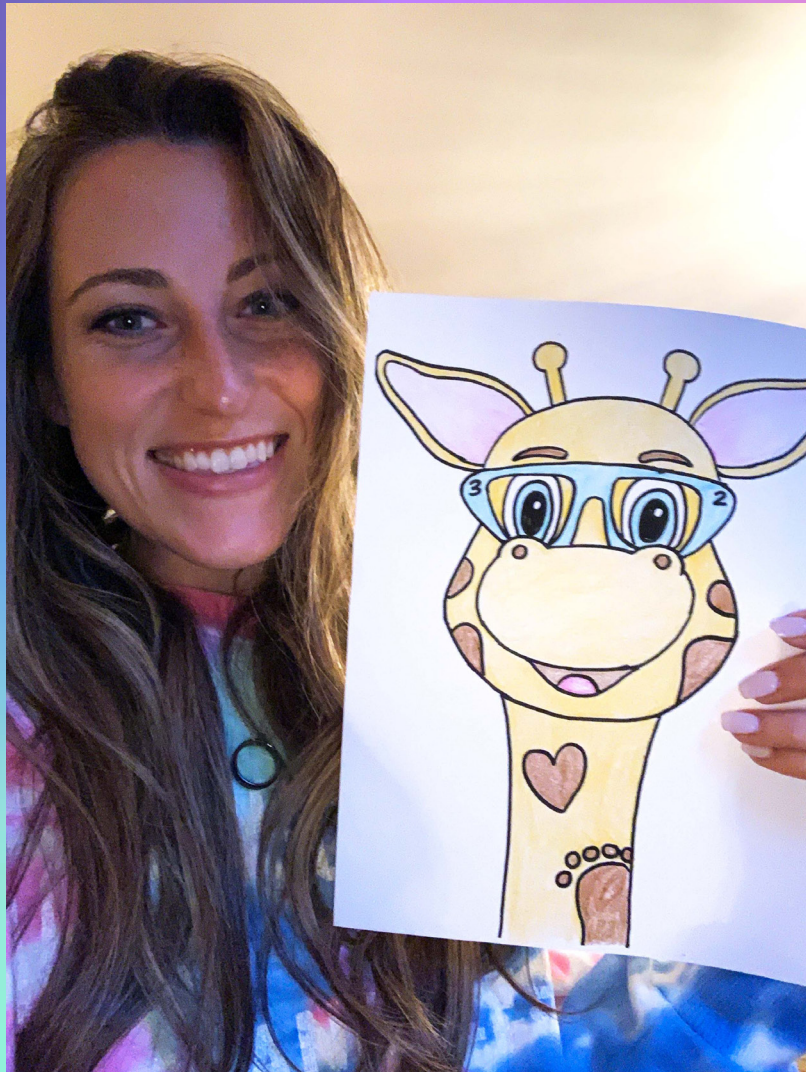

STEP 1

Start by drawing a bowl shape in the middle of the page.

It should look like an unfinished oval!

This is going to be GEO's nose.

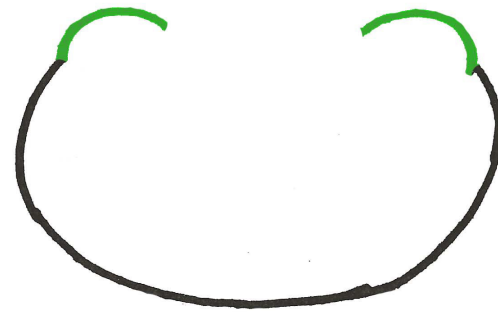


STEP 2

Now, draw 2 small semi-circles that connect to the oval.

But leave space in the middle!

That leads us to Step 3...

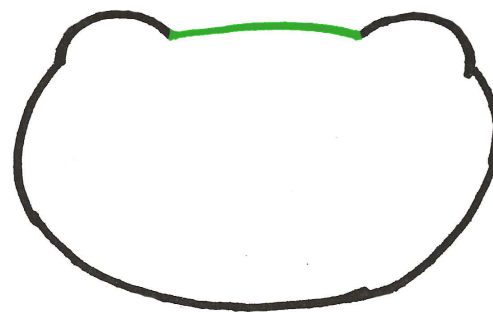


STEP 3

Connect the oval!

It shouldn't be a straight line. Make sure it has some curve.

Just one more step to complete GEO's nose...



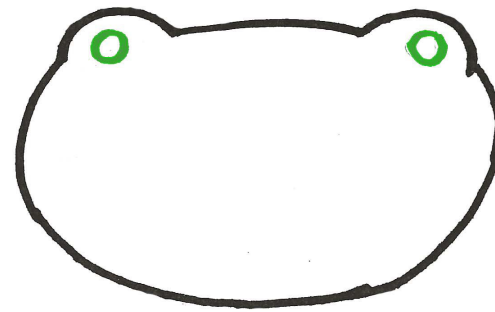
STEP 4

Add 2 little circles!

These are GEO's nostrils.

And now we're done with his nose!

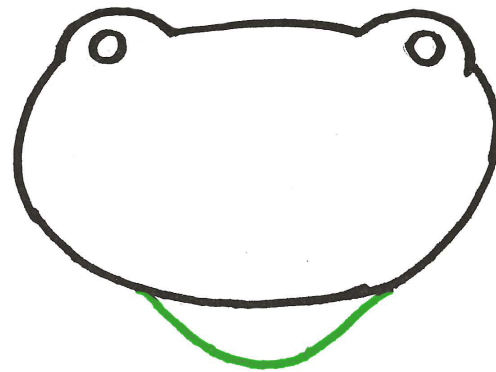
Let's move onto his mouth...



STEP 5

Now, add a 'U' shape
underneath GEO's nose.

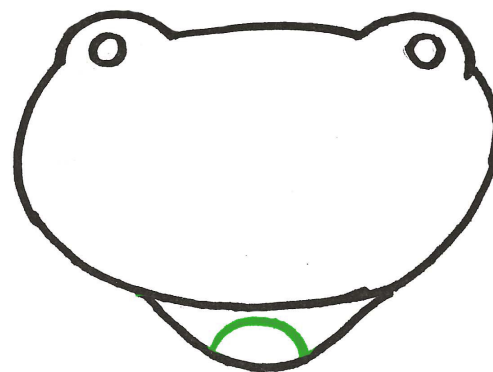
This will be his mouth!



STEP 6

Don't forget about his tongue!

Draw a little semi-circle inside your 'U' shape.



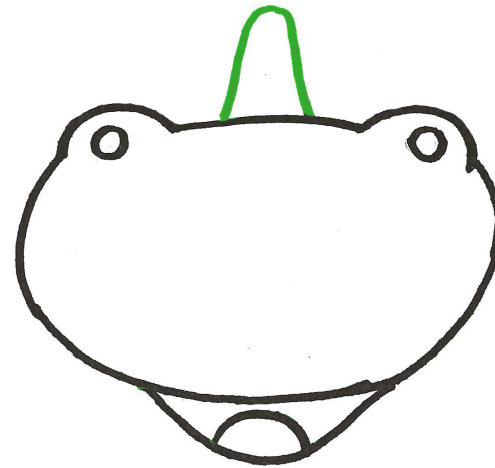
STEP 7

Let's move onto his glasses!

The reason I started with GEO's nose is because that part is in the foreground...

Meaning, it's the closest thing to us. So, everything else we draw will be behind his nose.

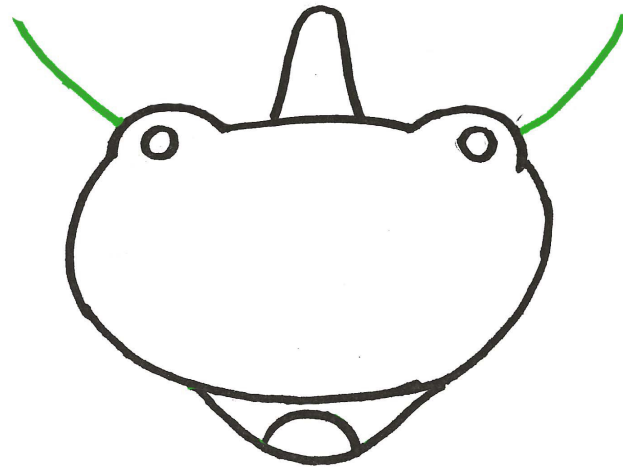
Let's start with a hill shape above the bridge of his nose.



STEP 8

Now, starting from each nostril, draw lines going out and up towards the corners of your paper.

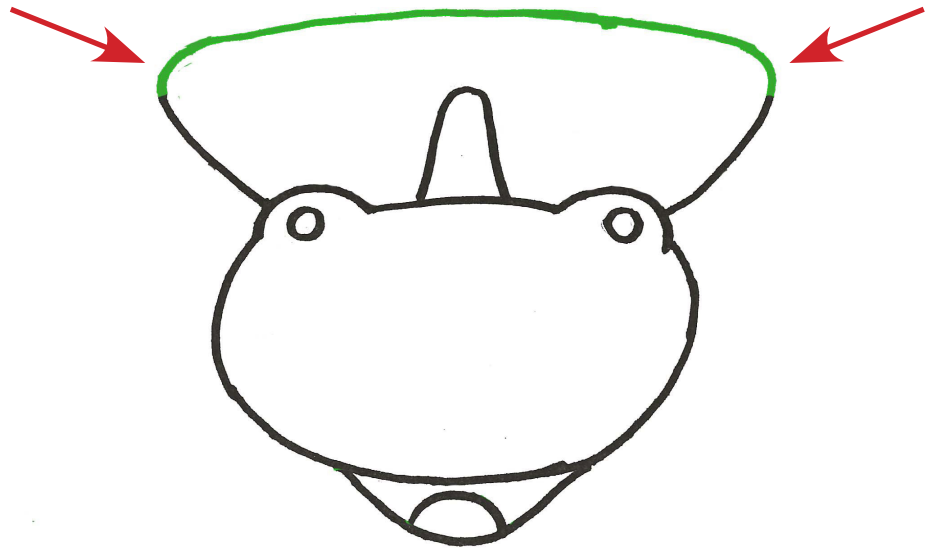
The lines should have a slight curve.



STEP 9

Connect these 2 lines with another curve!

Make sure the points of GEO's glasses are curved, and not pointy!
(See arrows)



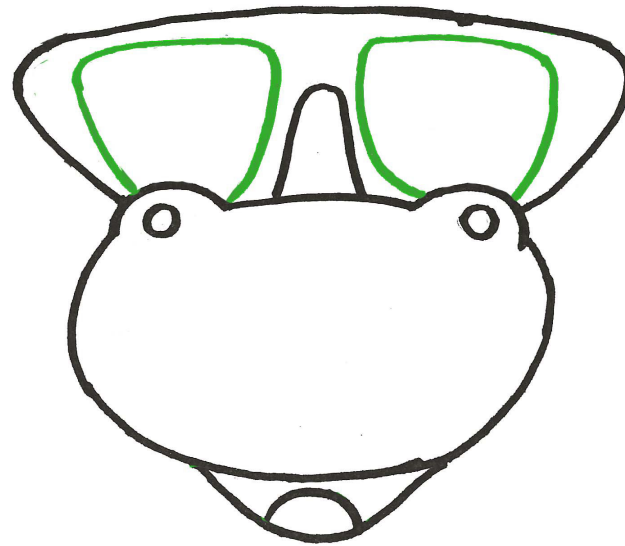
STEP 10

Let's add lenses to these glasses!

These are going to look like upside-down triangles! But the points should be curved.

And the tip of the triangle will be hiding behind GEO's nose!

Try to follow the same shape of the frames that we just drew.



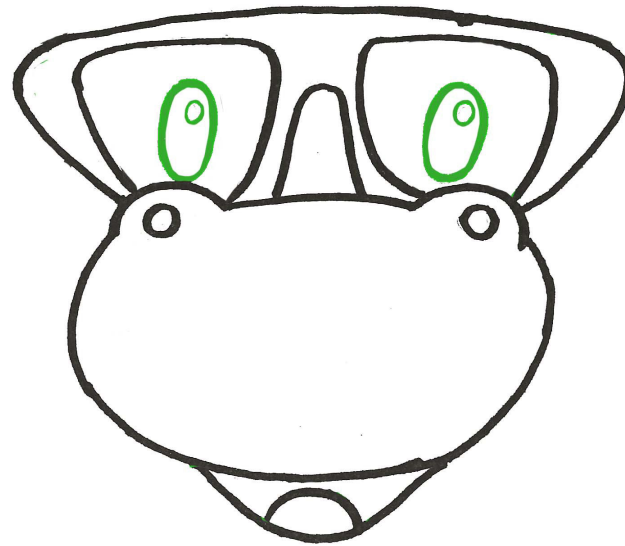
STEP 11

Time for the eyes!

Let's start with the pupils.
Draw 2 ovals in the center
of each lens.

But leave space for the
irises around each pupil!

Then, add a small circle on
the inside of each oval.
This adds shine to GEO's
eyes!

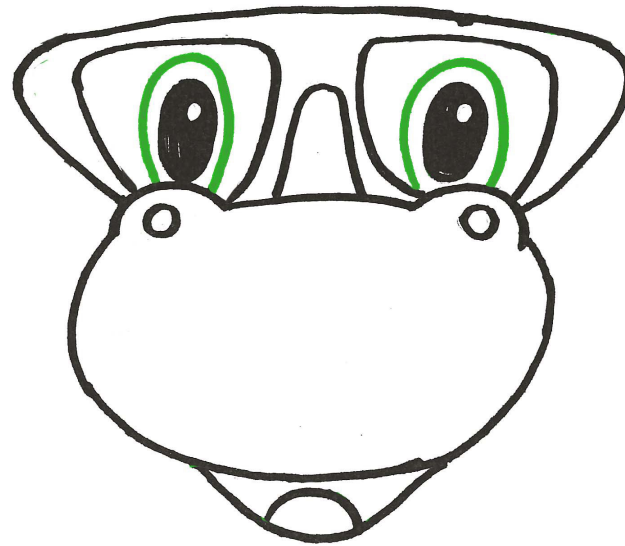


STEP 12

I colored my pupils black because I'm using a sharpie, but you can do this later when you color GEO!

Now, add an oval around the pupil. Try to follow the same shape.

And don't forget - the bottom of his eyes are behind his nose, so it shouldn't be a complete oval.

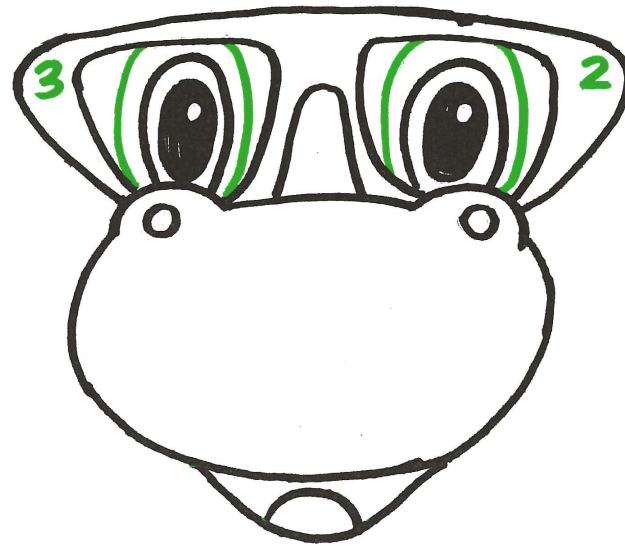


STEP 13

To finish up the eyes, add another oval shape around the oval you just drew.

Because this oval is hiding behind GEO's nose and glasses, you may have to erase the top and bottom of the ovals.

You can also add a '3' and a '2' on the glasses now.



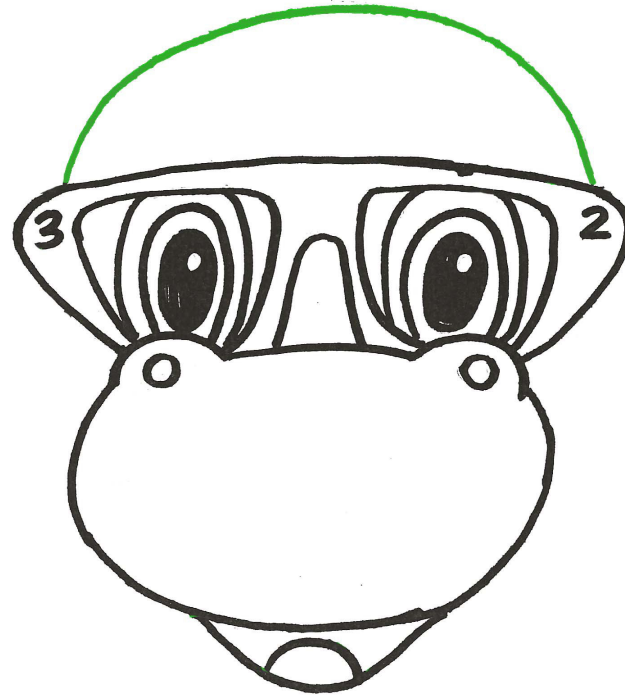
STEP 14

Time for the head!

Let's start with a dome, or a rainbow shape – starting near the '3' and ending near the '2' on GEO's glasses.

It's really starting to look like GEO now, isn't it!?

But he looks a little bald...

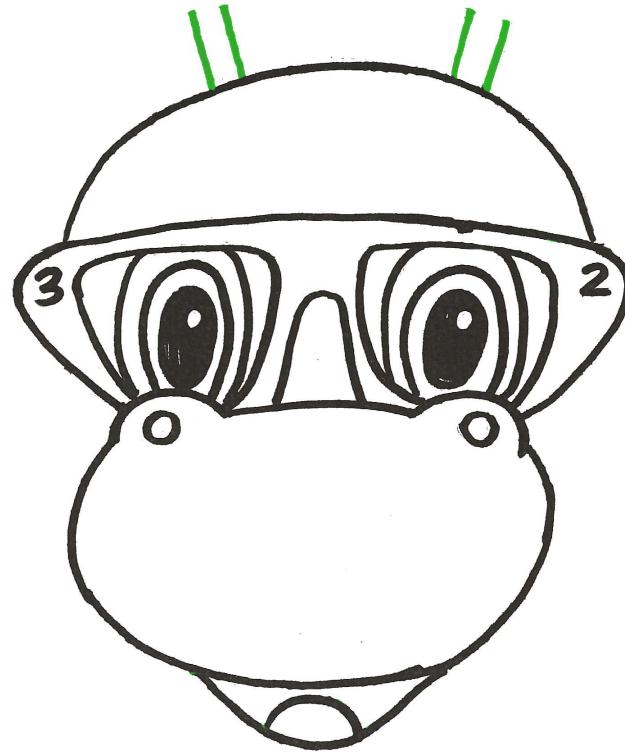


STEP 15

Let's add ears and
ossicones!

*Did you know the horns on
a giraffe's head are called
ossicones!?*

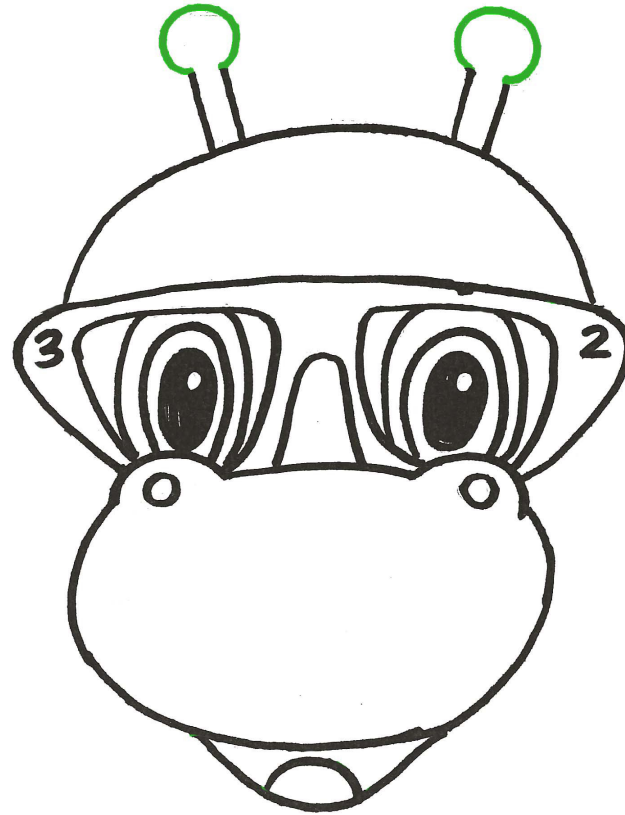
Start by drawing 2 short
lines on each side of GEO's
head.



STEP 16

Then connect each set of lines with a circular shape.

He kind of looks like an alien now, right!? Haha!



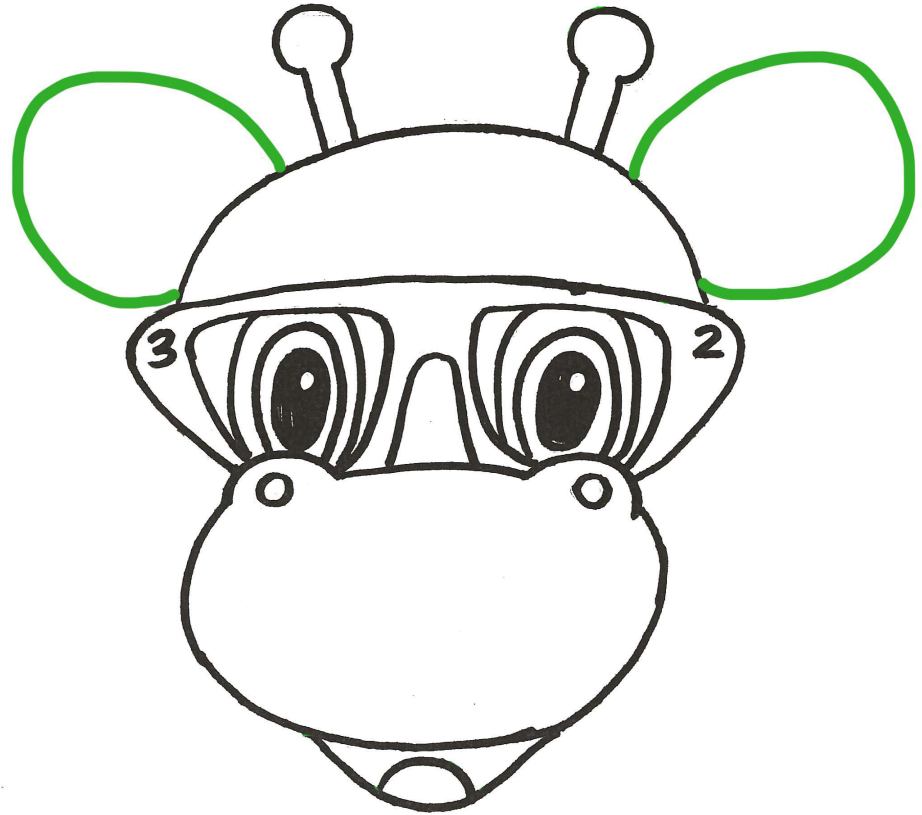
STEP 17

Let's give him ears!
Which might be a little
tricky...

Start with semi-circles on
each side of the ossicones,
reaching his glasses.

He looks kind of like a
mouse now, right? Haha!

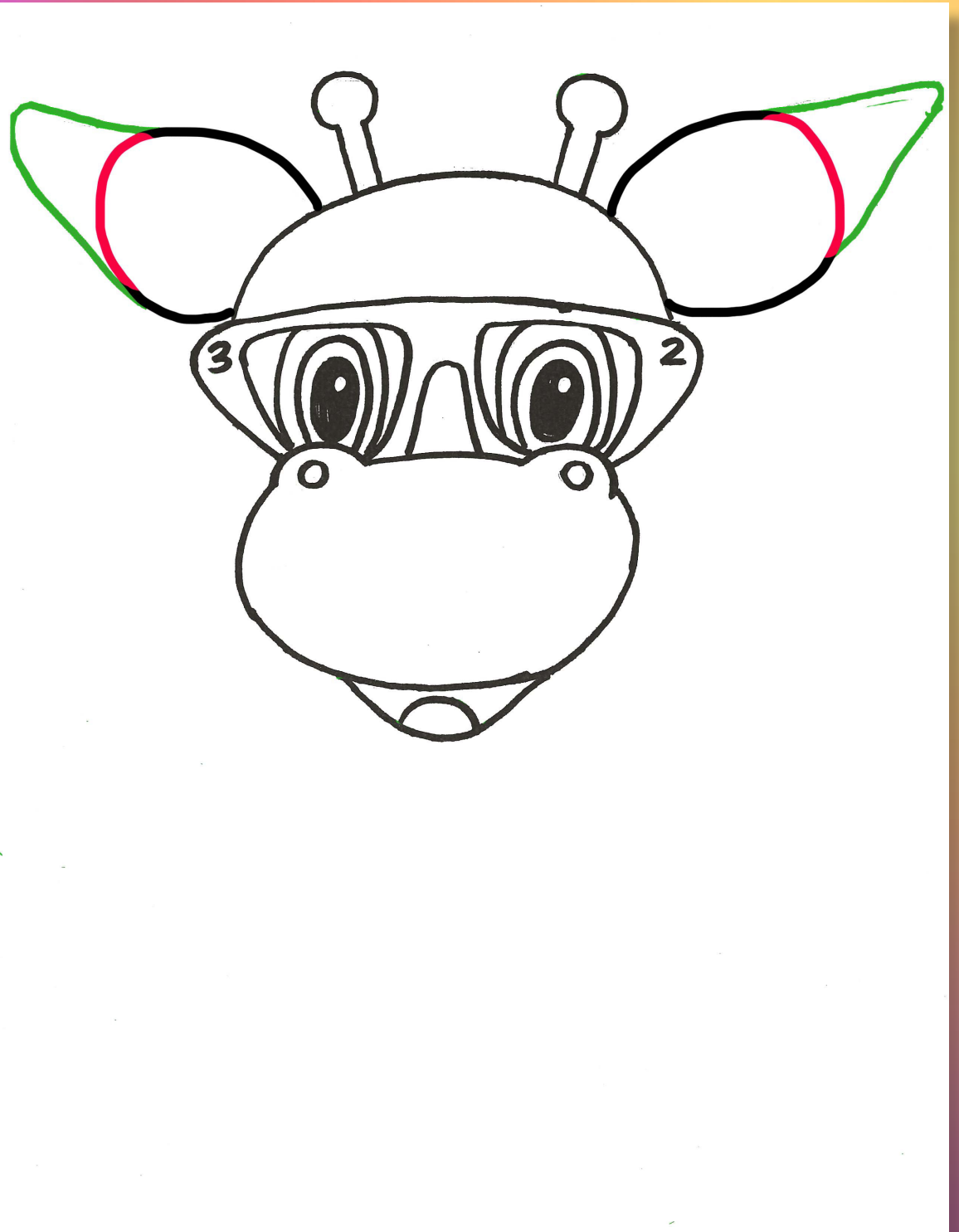
Don't worry - we'll fix that!



STEP 18

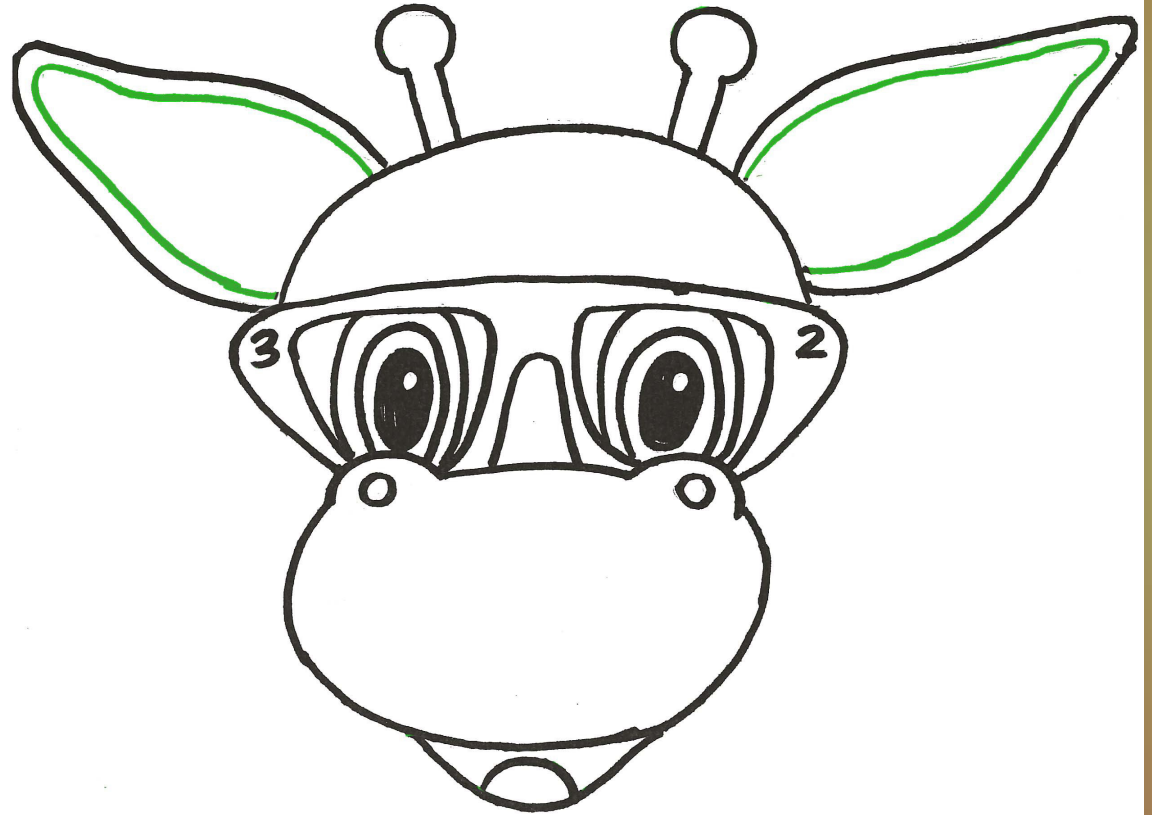
Now add the points to his ears, and erase the **red** lines that you see on my drawing.

The points are shaped like triangles!



STEP 19

To draw the insides of his ears, follow the shape of the outside lines that we just drew.



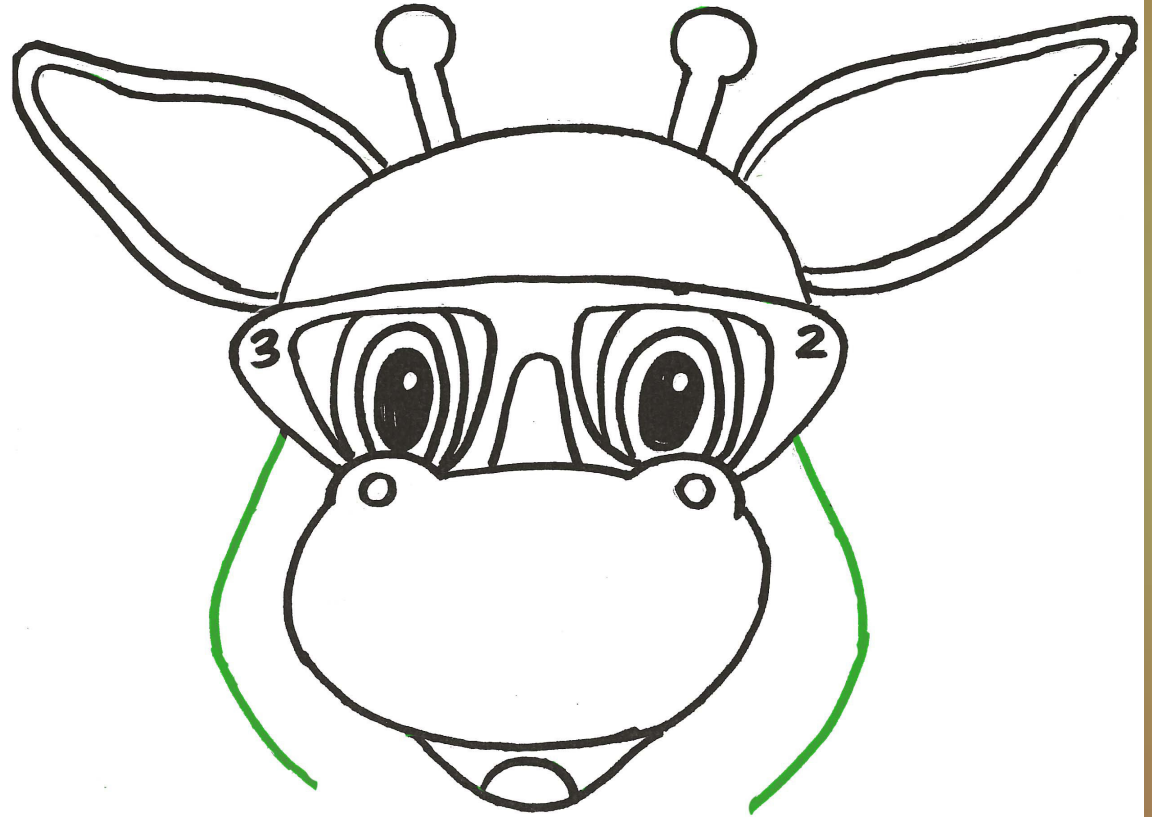
STEP 20

Just a few more steps!

Let's add GEO's cheeks now.

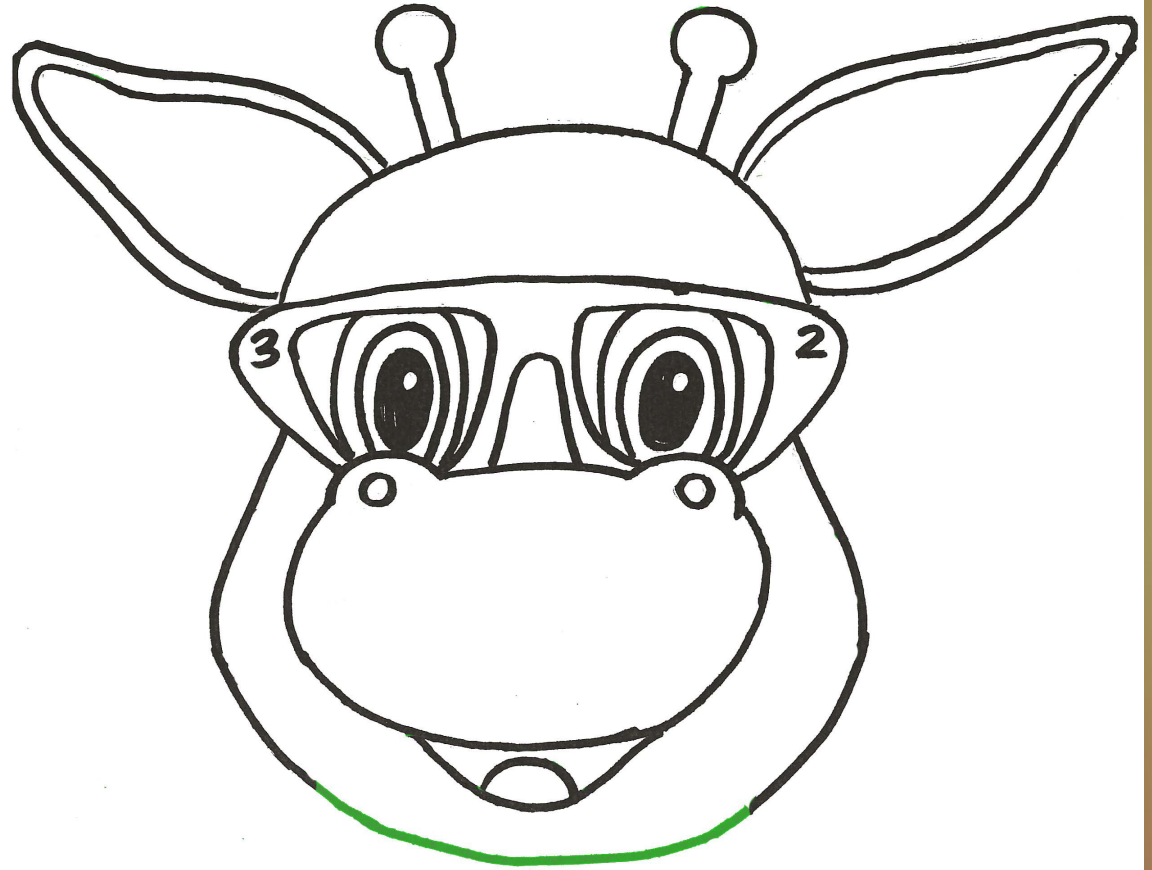
Create 2 curves on either side of his nose- starting at his glasses and ending a little below his mouth.

Try to follow the shape of his nose!



STEP 21

Now, add a curve underneath GEO's nose to connect the 2 lines we just drew.

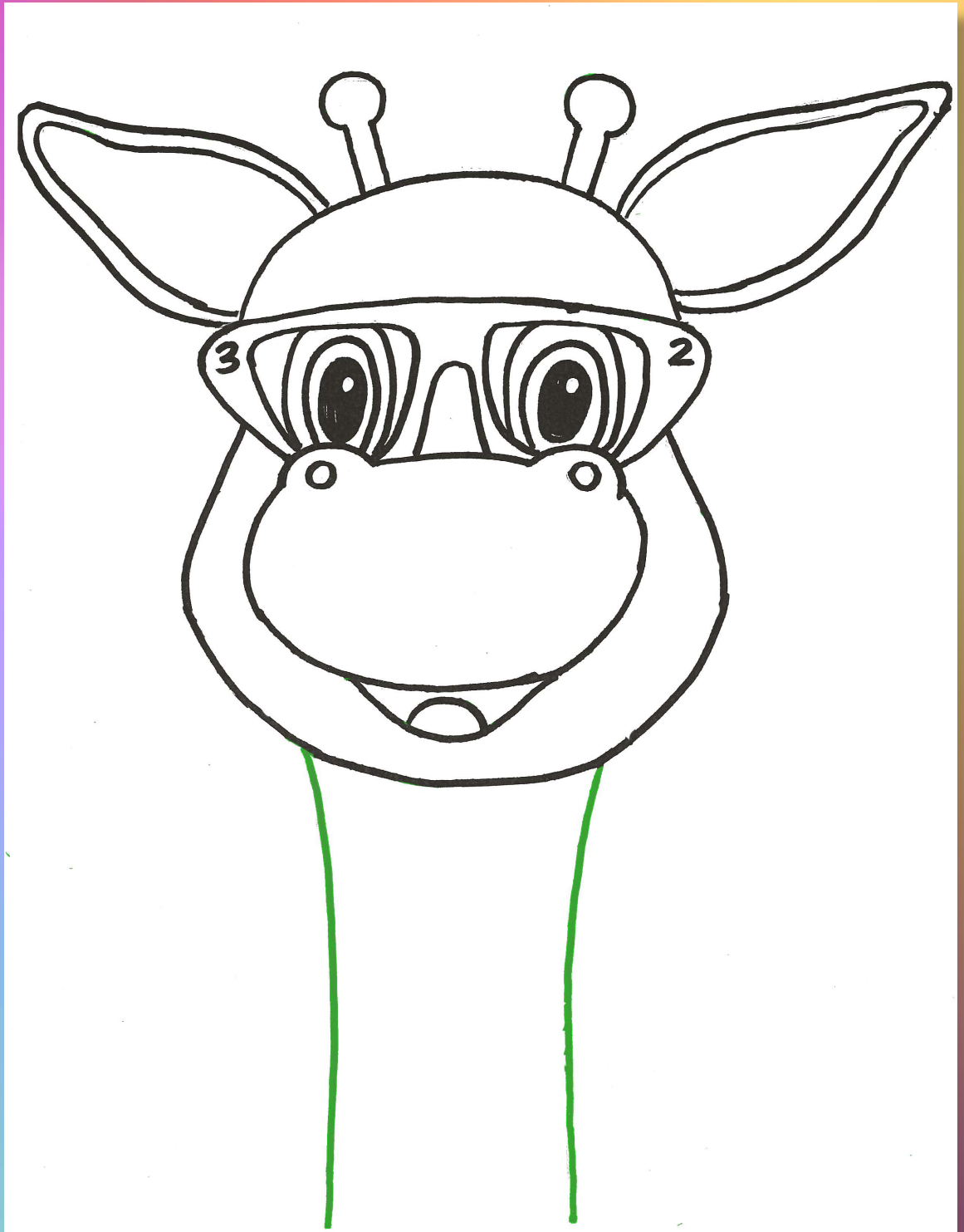


STEP 22

Moving onto the neck!

Below the line we just drew, draw 2 lines going down all the way to the bottom of your page.

These lines should be slightly curved inward.

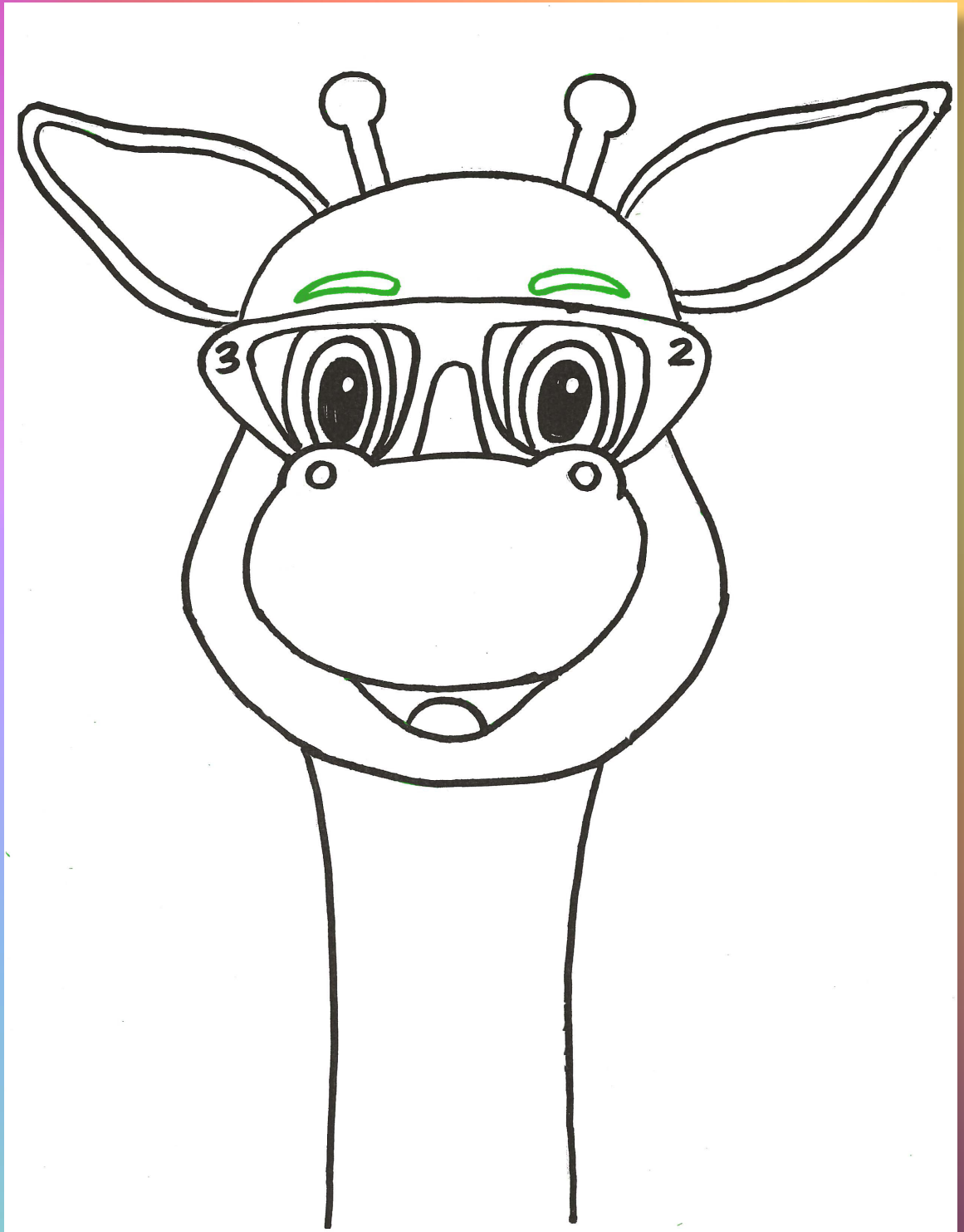


STEP 23

Almost done!

Let's add some detail –
starting with the eyebrows.

These shapes look a bit like
crescent moons, or half
moons.

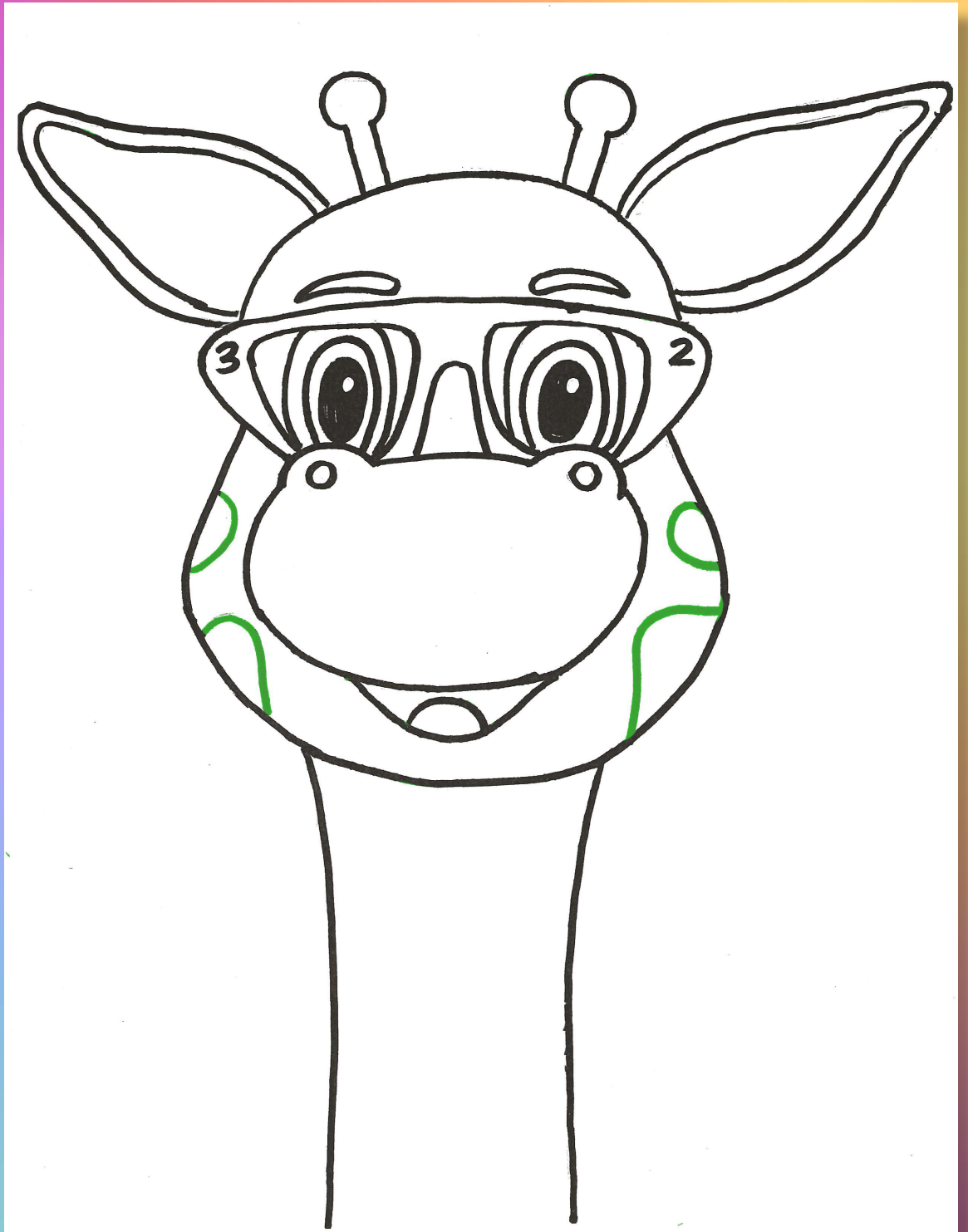


STEP 24

Now add some spots on his face!

These are also shaped like semi-circles.

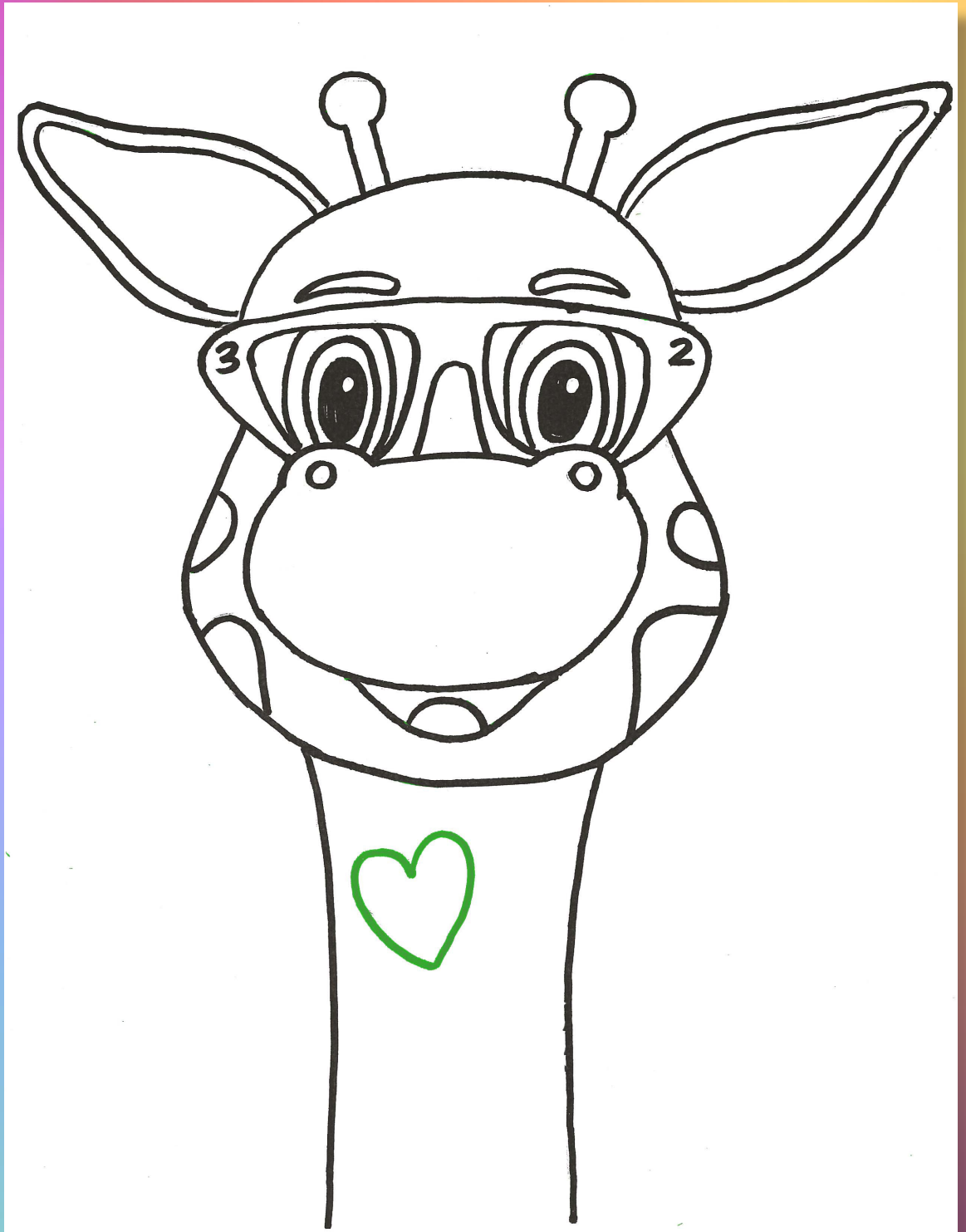
I added 2 spots on each side.



STEP 25

His neck looks a little
naked, doesn't it?

Let's add GEO's heart!

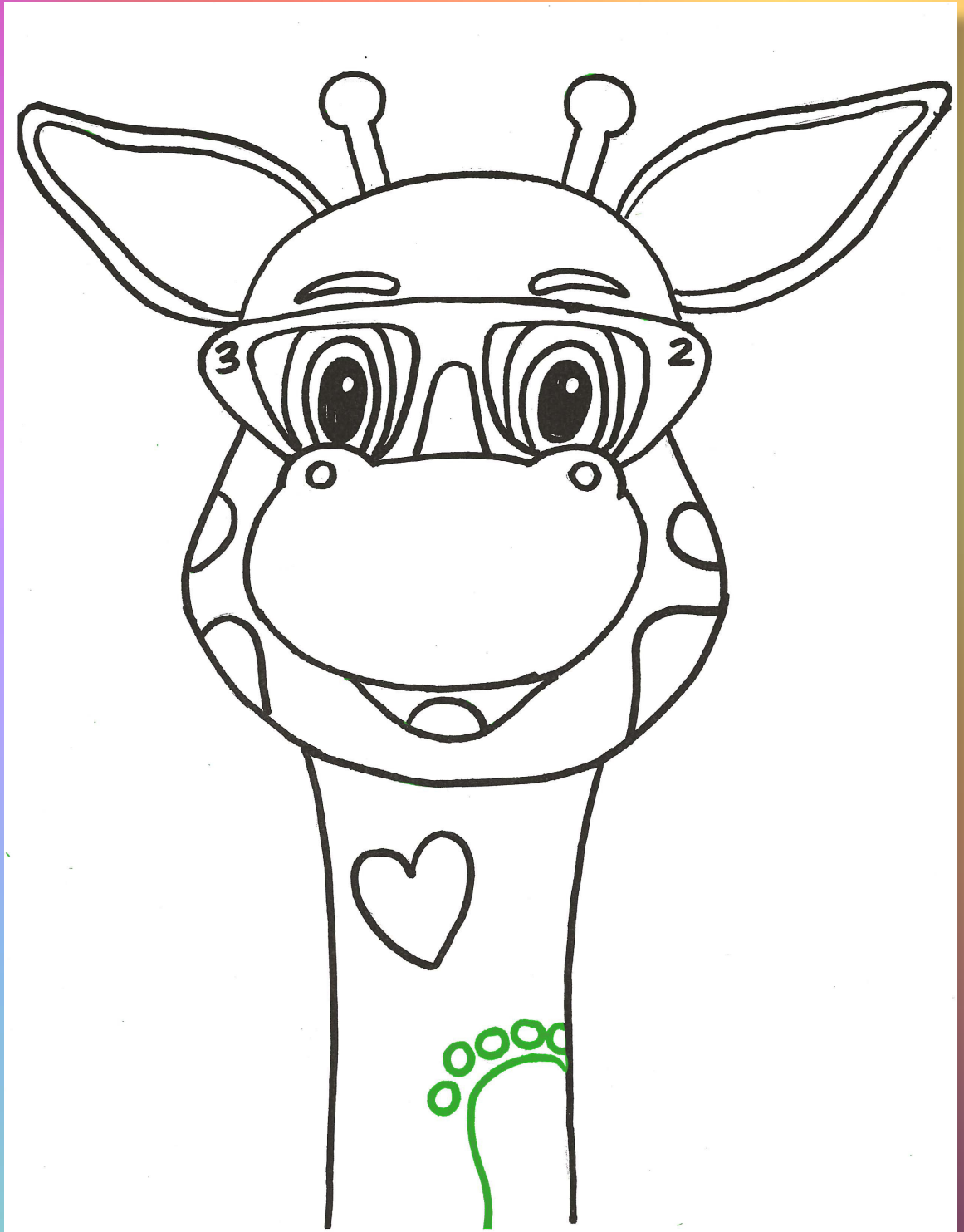


STEP 26

And finally...

Add the footprint!

Which is a hook shape,
with a few little circles
above it.



STEP 27

But don't forget to color him in!

Which is my favorite part.
